Transfer Students

Students who have taken courses before they matriculate are evaluated by the College Office, under Assistant Dean Frank Papovich. The College Departments only evaluate courses to be taken by students who are currently enrolled.

Transfer credit taken before matriculation may be used for fulfilling area requirements, or for fulfilling major requirements with special permission of the department. Dual enrollment credit, however, may not be used to fulfill competency requirements. Students in the College must take the second writing requirement in the College and earn a grade of at least C-.

Only 60 credits of transfer from other universities, foreign study, advanced placement, or dual enrollment may count toward the 120 credits needed for the B.A. or B.S. degree in the College.
